What is the Senior Ambassador Program?

The Wauwatosa Senior Commission has been appointed by the Mayor to enhance the quality of life of all older adults in Wauwatosa. The group's vision is to connect older adults to their community: its people, its activities and its resources.

The Senior Ambassadors will be the connection between older adults and their neighborhood associations. They will be in attendance at neighborhood events, block parties, citywide events and at the Farmers Market, where they will distribute Senior Resource Folders. At all these events, they will be wearing their Senior Ambassador polo shirts in "safety yellow," so they will be easy to spot.

The Senior Ambassador Program currently has 12 Senior Ambassadors representing nine neighborhood associations. The Senior Commission's goal is to have one or more Senior Ambassadors in each of the Wauwatosa's 31 neighborhood associations.
